Our focus is to highlight topics from the Key Communicator meeting that are most relevant to Hampton High School attendees and their families.

Highlights from the Meeting:

- On November 12th, at 7:30p, Dr. Imbarlina and the VEBH Architects will co-present an update to the School Board regarding the Academic Redesign/High School feasibility study. This will be the first public display of this information. All are welcome to attend.
- On November 14th, from 7p-8p, the Administration will present an overview for parents on ALICE and what the School District has done, and continues to do. All are encouraged to attend.
- On November 13th, the High School will host the annual Hampton Heroes event. There will be 3 speakers, a museum/display of members' service articles, and 8 inductees. All are welcome to attend.
- On December 12th, a High School Health Summit will be held during the school day. It will focus on helping the Seniors have a 'healthy' transition to college. Encouraging them to 'stay well' mentally and physically as they leave High School. Many overdoses in our community are occurring in the post-high school population. This Summit is meant to help address this growing concern.

- Save the date! January 17, 2019 - Hampton Community Opioid Partnership: This grass-roots endeavor will continue to grow. More details TBA.
- School Start Time: The Committee has expanded to include Key Communicators, a Teacher Representative, and Board Members. The research and consideration of a later start time for High School continues.
- The Hampton Township School District won a WPIAL Sportsmanship Award! It recognizes good sportsmanship across all WPIAL sports, and amongst the players, coaches, and spectators.
- During the Spring semester, the High School is going to offer an Online Statistics Class as a pilot program.
